To become intern-eligible, individuals must complete foundational courses, or pre-service. This meeting will go over the requirements for the pre-service and intern programs.

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Pre-Service Program Requirements

- Attend an Informational Meeting to learn about the program and determine eligibility
- Hold a Bachelor's degree (official transcripts from all colleges and universities required)
- Meet the Basic Skills Requirements through an exam, applicable coursework, or combination of exam and coursework. CL-667
- Certificate of Clearance or equivalent through CTC

Intern Program Requirements

All of the above plus....

- Successfully complete pre-service course work from an accredited program
- Attend an Advisement Meeting to determine eligibility
- Meet the Subject Matter Competency requirement-CSET exams or applicable Academic Degree Major
- Meet the US Constitution requirement (coursework or exam)
- Valid TB Test
- CPR Certification
- Provide receipt of an offer of employment as "Teacher of Record" from a participating district. (Employment must be at least .5 Full-Time Equivalent in the established credential area.)

Applications accepted March 10,2022-April 22,2022

*Per Executive Order N-66-20, flexibilities have been extended on the entrance requirements for intern programs regarding the passage of the Basic Skills Requirements (BSR) and Subject Matter Competency (SMC) for the 21/22 school year. BSR and SMC requirements must be met prior to the completion of an intern program.

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
