An Intern credential is a way for a student who is pursuing their teaching certificate to work as an educator and gain practical, first-hand experience as the primary educator within a classroom.

Intern-Eligible

Complete a 2 year program to earn a preliminary credential

Pre-Service

Successful completion of foundational coursework

Advisement Meeting

Learn about the program and determine eligibility

U.S. Constitution Requirement

Exam or Class

Verification of Employment

Teacher of record in a participating district

Informational Meeting

Learn about the program and determine eligibility

Bachelor's Degree

Official transcripts from all educational institutions

Basic Skills Requirement

For most, this is the CBEST

Subject Matter Competence

For most, this is the CSET

Certificate of Clearance

Background check and fingerprinting through CTC
